## You can do this by following some simple procedures outlined below:

- Learn to identify the plants around your area
- Do not pick pretty "flowers" you see and plant them in another area. You may be spreading noxious weeds.
- Do not drive on roadways and other areas not designated for motor vehicle use.
- Clean ATV's and other off-road vehicles of any plant material or seeds.
- Contact your County Weed Superintendent located under County Government in the phonebook if you see a plant that looks out of place or if you think you have identified a noxious weed.
- If you have a GPS, map the coordinates of a weed or patch of weeds and give those coordinates to your County Weed Superintendent.
